

Things to do and places to explore

Slow down and enjoy the unspoilt rural tranquillity of Herefordshire or take a visit to the nearby city of Hereford with its beautiful Cathedral and historic Mappa Mundi.

Explore one of the many 'black and white' villages and discover a wealth of local history, there are castles and ancient fortifications close at hand too. The church at Bredwardine is also worth a visit where Victorian diarist Francis Kilvert was once the incumbent.

Just 8 miles away is Hay-on-Wye with its unique collection of bookshops and famed international festival while there are friendly pubs and restaurants offering local food to be found all around us.

For the active and those with families the river offers canoeing and fishing. Cycling, riding and climbing are also readily available nearby.

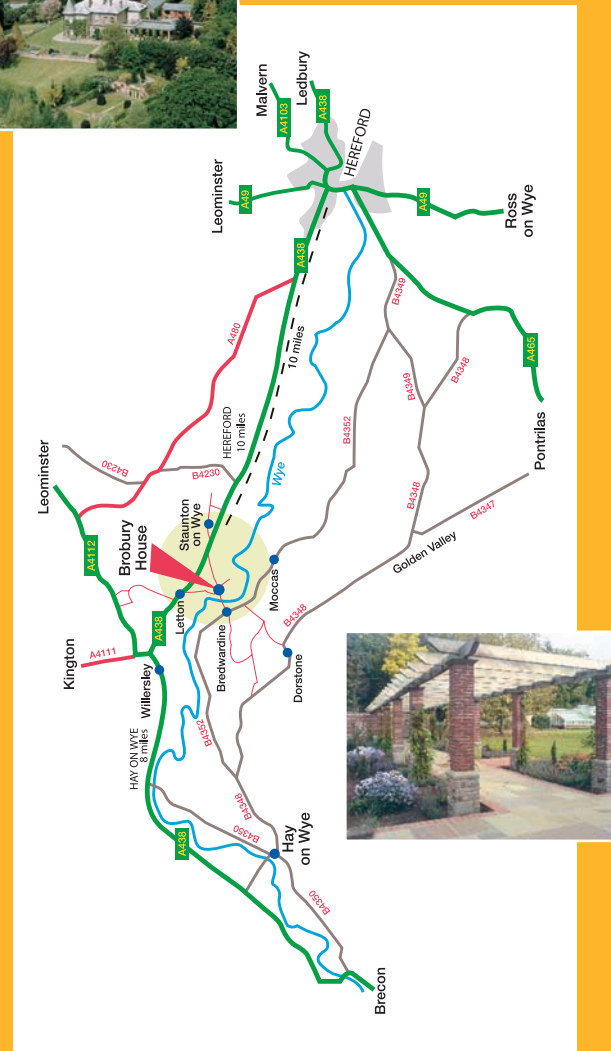
